BALLOT MEASURES

REFERENDUM 90 REJECTED

Concerning comprehensive sex education. Inappropriate curriculum, destroys local control.

ADVISORY VOTE 32 REPEALED

The legislature imposed a retail sales tax on pass-through charges retail establishments collect for specified carryout bags for government spending.

ADVISORY VOTE 33 REPEALED

The legislature imposed a tax on heavy equipment rentals to consumers by heavy equipment rental property dealers for government spending.

ADVISORY VOTE 34 REPEALED

The legislature increased the business and occupation tax rate for certain businesses, while reducing certain surcharges, for government spending.

ADVISORY VOTE 35 MAINTAINED

The legislature increased the business and occupation tax on manufacturers of commercial airplanes, including components or tooling, for government spending.

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 8212 REJECTED

A constitutional amendment on investment of public funds. This tax proposal violates principles of fairness and uniformity.
